

MC115 Classic Claw


Providing a simple solution to small ruminant milking.

MC110A Classic Claw Valve

These individual milk claw valves incorporate a unique shut-off to automatically control the vacuum supply to each liner.

- Opens when the teat is inserted into the liner
- Rapid air inlet when the liner is removed from the teat close the valve
- This allows optimum use of vacuum by reducing vacuum fluctuation and minimizing air consumption.
- Fewer operations during milking
- A manual lever allows the valve to be held open during washing.

Suitable Pulsators

For simultaneous 2:0 pulsation, where one main tube supplies both liners the PL80 will provide the required rate and ratio with a single outlet nipple.

For alternate 2:1 pulsation, where each liner has a main pulse tube back to the pulsator, suitable for use with a Vanguard claw MC130C. The PL190 will provide the require rate and ration from its twin outlets. The same PL190 pulsator can also be use to provide simultaneous 2:0 pulsation to 2

individual clusters, as used on the DB222 twin cluster portable milking machine for goats or sheep.
